Two species of frogs are endemic to the microhabitats of Costa Rica's foothills, Hylomantis lemur in the Caribbean foothills and Duellmanohyla rufioculis in the Caribbean and Pacific foothills. This zone ranges from about 2,300 feet to 4,900 feet on the Pacific slope and 2,000 feet to 4,600 feet on the Caribbean slope.
