For general work you will need at least 30in, and preferably 36in, photo 2. Incidentally, lathe dimensions are still mainly given in imperial measurements; for metric buffs the equivalents are 760 and 915mm.

The engine portion of the wood lathe has convection holes for cooling. The convection holes coupled with the conductivity of the steel helps prevent overheating. It uses a ball-bearing motor that has a maximum speed of 7000 rpm. The control tunes between 0 and 7000 rpm continuously.
